1. Court to approve the minutes of the previous meeting.
2. Court to approve any line item/budget amendments.
3. Court to approve payment for all bills relating to Clay County Memorial Hospital.
4. Court to examine and possibly approve all accounts, payroll and reports relating to the finances of the County and audit and settle all accounts against the County and direct their payments.
5. Court to hear from any persons desiring to appear before the court.
6. County Judge, Kenneth Liggett, to give updates on meetings and to provide information regarding events concerning Clay County.
7. Court to consider and possibly approve the County Treasurer's monthly report for January, 2007 and advertisement of affidavit of same.
8. Court to consider and possibly approve the recommendation by Peggy Shepherd for the 2007 - 2008 appointments to the Clay County Historical Commission.
9. Court to consider and possibly approve the request made by Peggy Shepherd, Chairman of the Clay County Historical Commission, to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with Clay County regarding the annual payment from Clay County to the Clay County Historical Commission.
10. Court to consider and possibly approve waiving the Service of Citation fees for liens filed by Clay County Memorial Hospital against bad debts.
11. Court to consider and possibly approve the recommendation of Hollis Adams, Superintendent of Midway Schools, to consolidate elections.
12. Court to consider and possibly approve the Proclamation presented by Kent Neville and Larry Duncan proclaiming March 4 - 10, 2007 as Severe Weather Awareness Week in Clay County.
13. Court to consider and possibly approve the Applications for Tax Refund as submitted by Macon Clark Boddy regarding property located at 315 S. Crockett, Henrietta, Texas and in Precinct #3. The applications are for the year 2004 in the amount of \$59.69 and for the year 2005 in the amount of \$59.75 with a total refund of \$119.44. These taxes were assessed in error.
14. Court to consider and possibly take any action necessary regarding options for hosting Clay County internet addresses.
15. Court to consider and possibly consolidate county voting precincts for May 12, 2007, election and also discuss possibility of joint elections with cities and schools and use of county election equipment.
