

ORDER SETTING THE 2019-20 PROPERTY TAX RATE
FOR CLAY COUNTY, TEXAS

Whereas, the Clay County Commissioner' Court has voted to set the tax revenue Levy for Tax Year 2019-20 in order to provide Funds with which to meet the Budget Requirement of the County, and to pay the expenses necessarily incurred in connection with The Services provided by the County to Clay County Residents: therefore,

BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT ON SEPTEMBER 23, 2019


That the levy for Tax Year 2019-20 is an ad valorem tax of \$.700000 per \$100 Assessed valuation on all taxable property within the County.

This tax rate is hereby adopted in the following components:

General Funds M & O	\$0.53881
Road & Bridge Funds	\$0.16119
Total 2019-20 Ad Valorem Tax Rate	\$0.70000

THIS RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAX REVENUE FOR MAINTENANCE & OPERATION AND ROAD & BRIDGE SERVICES THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.






